

## Coalition of Persons with Disabilities - Newfoundland and Labrador 2020 Scholarships Application Package

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The Coalition of Persons with Disabilities – Newfoundland and Labrador (COD-NL), in partnership with the West White Rose Project is pleased to provide two (2) scholarships to high school students who self-identify as living with a disability, and entering post-secondary studies in September 2020.

### To be eligible, candidates must be:

- Graduating from high school;
- A Canadian citizen who self-identifies as living with a disability;
- Entering a Canadian post-secondary institution; and
- Unrelated to any member of the COD-NL Board of Directors or staff.

### Selection Committee:

The Coalition of Persons with Disabilities - Newfoundland and Labrador Scholarship Program is administered by a Selection Committee, comprised of representatives from the Coalition's Board of Directors, West White Rose Project, and community partners from other disability organizations.

### Selection Criteria:

The criteria considered in awarding the scholarship includes academic achievements, community engagement, and academic and career goals.

### To Submit:

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## Submission Guide

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All applications for the Coalition of Persons with Disabilities Newfoundland and Labrador 2020 Scholarships must be accompanied by the following three (3) supporting documents:

1. One letter of reference from a past or current teacher;
2. One letter of reference from a person who has known the applicant for a minimum of one year, **other than a relative or teacher**; and
3. Official academic transcripts covering the past two (2) years of study. Including, last year's complete transcripts and the current year's transcripts **up to the most recently available**.

Please note that official final marks will be requested from successful candidates.

Candidates must ensure that all pages of this application are complete, including signature of school representative found on page 6 of this package.

**Completed applications are due no later than 4pm on Wednesday, June 10th, 2020.**

**Scholarship winners will be notified by July 2020 and invited to attend a scholarship announcement in September 2020.**

West White Rose Project Scholarship Program - **\$1250**

The West White Rose Project Scholarships are valued at \$1250.00 each and will be awarded to two (2) successful candidates enrolled in a post-secondary program that is within the Oil & Gas Sector, such as:

- Health & Occupational Safety
- Information Technology
- Supply Chain and Logistics
- Technical Trades
